Flooding and water management



"We will deliver on our commitment to improve natural flood management, such as improving the quality of water courses to protect against soil erosion and damage to vulnerable habitats and communities."



Investing in flood defences and natural flood management. Introduce a long-term 25 year target for water quality.

Labour will give the Fire and Rescue Services a statutory duty to coordinate and respond to floods.
Will fund "robust flood resilience".

Establish a £2 billion flood-prevention fund to support small community and council-led schemes to reduce upstream flooding, and downstream and coastal knock-on effects.
Promise to improve flood defences and introduce high standards for flood resilience for buildings and infrastructure in flood-risk areas.
Protect and restore England's lakes, rivers and wetlands. Reform of water management and higher water-efficiency standards.
