“Realise the full potential of the Green Investment Bank by increasing its capitalisation, expanding its remit, allowing it to raise funds independently and enabling it to issue green bonds.”

“Help incentivise sustainable behaviour by increasing the proportion of tax revenue accounted for by green taxes”.

Set up an Office for Environmental Responsibility.
Tackle environmental and wildlife crime with increased enforcement and tougher penalties.
Introduce a package of sustainability and circular economy measures under a Resource Efficiency and Zero Waste Act.



Pledge to “protect hunting, shooting and fishing, for all the benefits to individuals, the environment and the rural economy that these activities bring. A Conservative Government will give Parliament the opportunity to repeal the Hunting Act on a free vote, with a government bill in government time.”

Implement various measures to crack down on illegal wildlife trade.



Provide greater support to tackle wildlife crime.
End sport shooting and ban snares.

Use taxation and regulation to ensure products are designed with end-of-life in mind, reducing waste and increasing recycling.

Would oblige government departments and local authorities to consider climate change and carbon reduction in all their planning over the long term of 50–100 years.



Increase capital available to the Green Investment Bank.
Will continue to develop zero waste strategy.



Industrial strategy for the green economy, with more powers for the Green Investment Bank.

Pledge to defend the hunting ban and deal with wildlife crime associated with shooting.



Transfer full responsibility for Welsh natural resources to National Assembly.
Oppose opencast mining.



Would compile a National Brownfield Register, and remediation assessment where appropriate, as well of grants of up to £10,000 for remediation to encourage house building here.
