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### Minutes of the AGM held at 12.30pm, 20th April 2021, Online Zoom Meeting

Adam Donnan (AD) highlighted that the format of the online AGM had worked well in 2020 and allowed for the participation of members from around the globe, and given the ongoing impact of Covid-19, it was decided to repeat the format this year. He encouraged any members who had not voted yet, to do so through the voting tool in the Members' Area.

Gary Kass (GK), the IES Chair, reflected on the past year and his term of office as IES Chair. He highlighted the importance of COP26 later this year. He recorded his thanks to all the trustees who has supported him throughout his term in office and thanked the IES staff team and members. A summary of his speech can be found in the annual report.

AD reviewed the work of the IES in 2020 to help members through the pandemic and looked forward to the rest of the year. He spoke about how the office, trustees and members had all shown remarkable powers of adaptation. He highlighted that membership engagement has increased through the extensive use of video conferencing software.

lan Byrne (IB), the IES Treasurer, gave a review of the 2019-20 accounts. He highlighted that it was a solid financial period, given the circumstances with income growing 4%. The full accounts can be found online. He outlined that the IES was in good shape to weather the pandemic.

The new IES Strategy for 2021-24, Guiding Transformative Change, was launched at the AGM. AD talked through the strategy.

The meeting moved onto the resolutions. Voting took place entirely through the Members' Area of the website.
