I am pleased to confirm that The Institution of Environment Sciences will continue to strive to become climate neutral through its commitment to Climate Neutral Now, to support global society in achieving climate neutrality<sup>1</sup>.

In signing this pledge, I also commit my entire organisation<sup>2</sup> to continue to undertake the following in becoming GHG emission neutral for the selected GHGs<sup>3</sup> (Carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>); Methane (CH<sub>4</sub>); Nitrous oxide (N<sub>2</sub>O); Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs); Perfluorocarbons (PFCs); and Sulphur hexafluoride (SF<sub>6</sub>)):

1. Measure (quantify) our greenhouse gas emissions;
2. Reduce those emissions through own action;
3. Compensate any remaining emissions by offsetting, including through use of Certified Emission Reductions (CERs).
