

Guidelines for IES Student blog submissions

Focus – Stories of Action

- The Institution of Environmental Sciences (IES) is a charitable organisation which promotes and raises public awareness of environmental science.'.
- This student blog is an opportunity for IES student members to discuss
 - an initiative, project, campaign or society you are part of related to climate action, sustainability or the environment, what you have done or aiming to do, and what the outcomes were/projected outcomes will be

Length

- Blogs should be between 500-750 words.
- Please include a title for your blog post of no more than 10 words.

Images

- We encourage authors to include photos or graphics with their submission. Please supply these as separate JPG or PNG files photos or graphics embedded in Word, Excel or PowerPoint files are compressed, reducing the quality and include a relevant caption in the text of the blog.
- Please ensure you own the copyright for any graphics or photos submitted or have secured permission from the creator to reproduce this work on the IES website.

Referencing

- Please include references as hyperlinks within the text. A reference list at the end of the blog is not required.
- To reference a non-digital or physical source, please use endnotes formatted as numbers (not Roman numerals).

Author biography

• Please provide a brief description of your current role and background (no more than 30 words) to be included with the blog. A contact email address can be included if you would like readers to be able to contact you.

• If you wish to provide a photograph of yourself, please supply this as a separate JPG or PNG file along with your blog post.

Style of writing

- Writing should be clear, concise and intended for a scientifically literate audience. Please keep in mind that readers come from a broad range of professional backgrounds, so may not be familiar with sector-specific terms or concepts these should be defined at first usage.
- All blogs should be written in English using British spelling, except for quoted text.
- Please avoid introductory phrases such as 'In this blog, I will...' and go straight into the discussion.

Editing and submission process

- Please submit your blog as a Word document (.doc or .docx), along with any accompanying photos or graphics, via email to <u>education@the-ies.org</u> with the subject 'IES student blog submission'.
- All submissions are reviewed and edited before publication. A final version of your blog will be shared with you ahead of publication to ensure that the meaning of the text has been preserved.
- If revisions to the blog are required ahead of publication, we will get in touch with specific comments or suggestions.
- If you have a topic in mind but are unsure if it would be suitable for a blog post, please contact education@the-ies.org with your idea and a brief bulleted outline of the blog's content.
