
Survey Respondents




...but **80%** of members didn't know we had a twitter account.






Proportion of members rating services as 'very important' or 'important'








94% of members rate their interaction with the office as 'excellent' or 'good'.


hroughout 2013 the IES published a range of analysis documents.

79% of members rate the IES web publications as important or very important.

















Policy


17 Professional body membership
