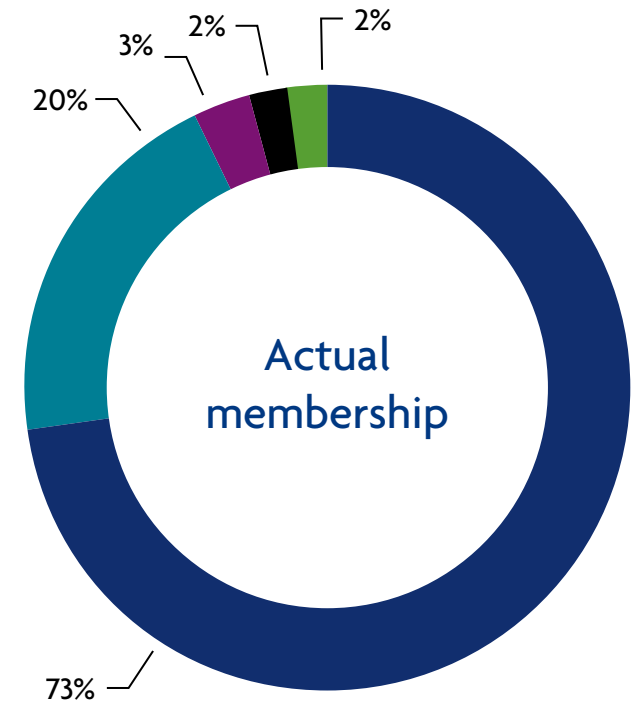
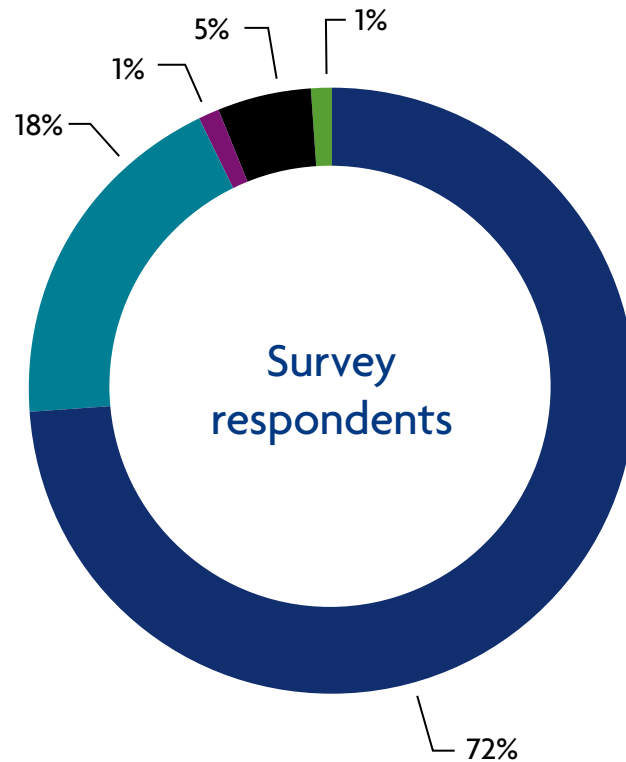

The proportion of respondents in each membership category compared to the actual IES membership



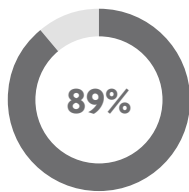

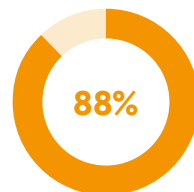

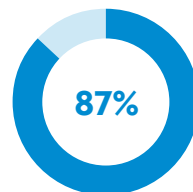
Proportion of members rating services as 'very important' or 'important'



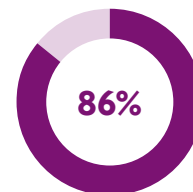

Based on feedback from last year's membership survey we developed and launched an online CPD recording tool.

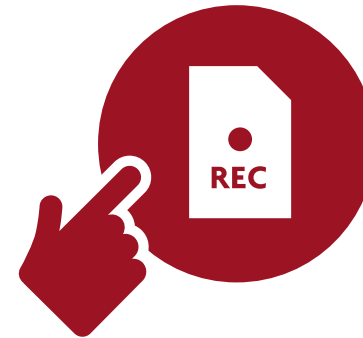
We'll be helping more members to make use of the tool in 2015.

Our most popular report was the 2014 Salary Survey, with 68% of respondents finding it 'very' or 'moderately' interesting.

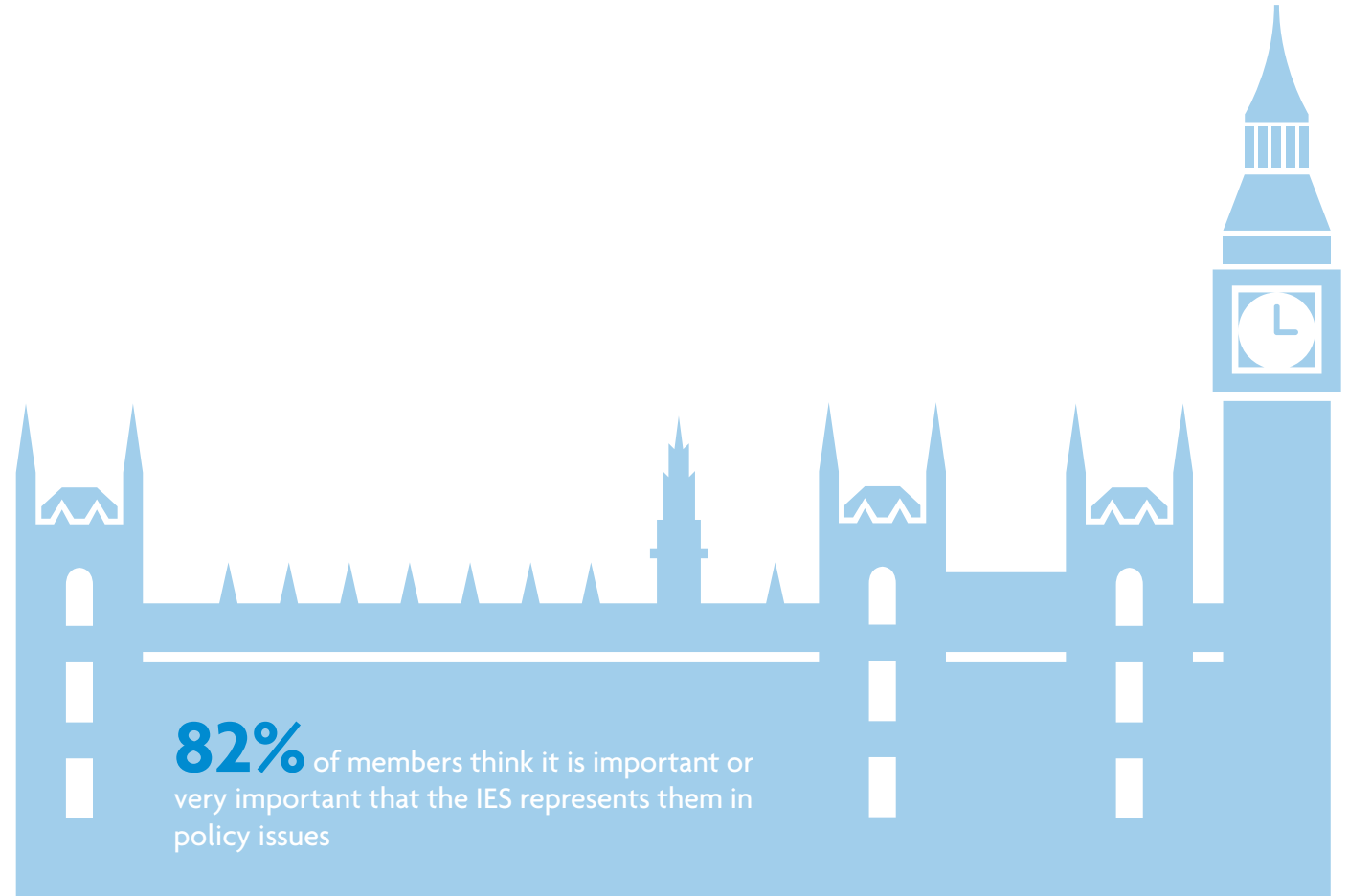

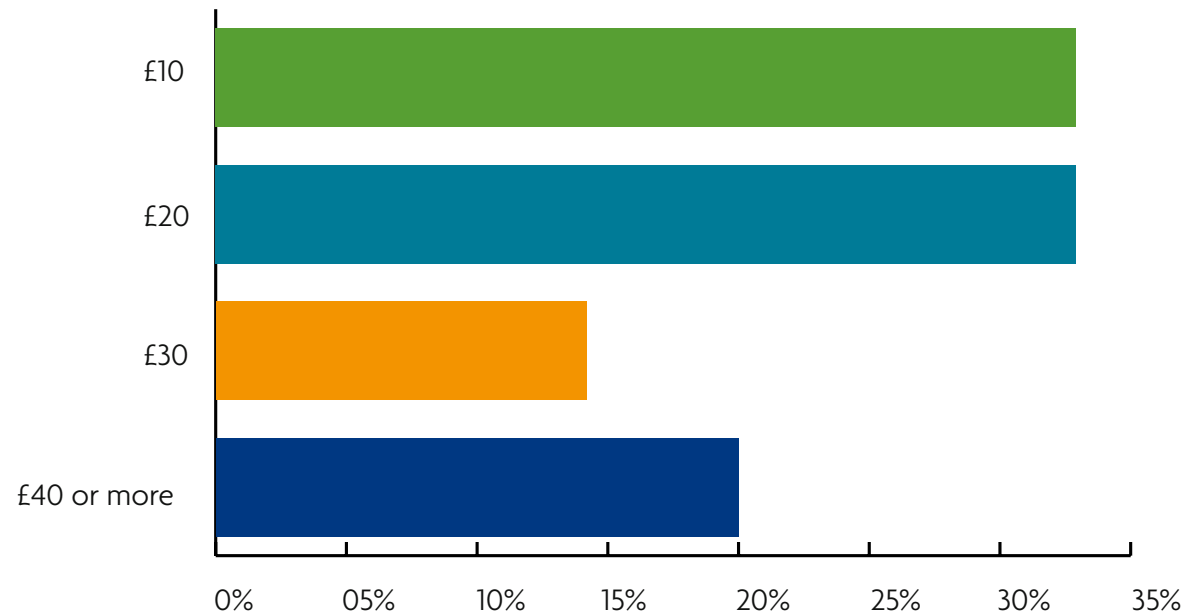
