## Edinburgh Agglomeration: Draft Noise Action Plan Response from Environmental Protection Scotland December 2013

- · embedded in regional and national strategic planning
- informed by expert groups

## **General Comments**

Environmental Protection Scotland welcomes the Draft Noise Action Plan for the Edinburgh Agglomeration. We would like to commend the Edinburgh Noise Working Group and SENSG for the work taken since the last round of mapping to identify Noise Management Areas and Quiet Areas. EPS hope that this new draft plan is supported by sufficient resources to implement the proposed actions listed in Section 5.6.

We note a new Local Transport Strategy will be developed in 2014 and we hope that it includes provisions within this Draft Noise Action Plan. Similarly we hope that local authority and Scottish Government colleagues working on this action plan work closely with air quality colleagues with the aim of integrating and developing both sets of action plans.

Environmental Protection Scotland would like to congratulate the Working Group and SENSG for producing another set of clear, concise strategic noise maps from a multitude of data.

We would like to see both SENSG and the Working Group to proactively communicate this information to the public so that they are aware of what is happening in their region and to ensure that action planning is widely understood by the public.
